AMATEUR INSTRUCTOR ELIGIBILITY

A dancer who meets the following requirements is eligible to apply and submit for the Amateur Teacher Examination.

- The Amateur must be a Championship registered dancer in good standing with the National Dance Council of Canada (NDCC).
- The Amateur must be at least seventeen (17) years of age as of the day of the examination.
- The Amateur Instructor must work under the guidance of a Professional Mentor during training and after passing the Amateur Teacher Exam.
- The Amateur Instructor must pass an examination based on the Student Teacher Syllabus. If the trainee is instructing both Standard and Latin-American, an examination must be passed in both styles. These examinations may be taken separately.

IMPORTANT TO NOTE:

The gaining of an instructing accreditation by an Amateur competitor is not an opening to conduct a business as a coach by operating one's own studio.
