

CDF LAPSED MEMBERSHIP OPERATING POLICY Revised July, 2023

Qualified Members

Lapsed Membership

A **Qualified Member**, whose CDF membership has lapsed, may renew their membership by paying for the current year, plus the normal late fee if paid after January 31st of any given year, plus the previous year's fee. This would total two year's membership and, in some cases, an additional late fee penalty.

<u>Note 1</u>

A **Qualified Member** with a lapsed membership will be deemed "Not in Good Standing", removed from the Adjudicator List, and their file marked "Inactive".

Note 2

A **Qualified Member**, wanting to rejoin CDF without paying back fees, may rejoin as a **General Member**, at any time. There will be no further penalty, other than a late fee for the current year, if applicable. Their name will **not** be placed on the Adjudicator List.

<u>Note 3</u>

A **Qualified Member** may request, in advance, a waiver of membership fee payment under certain circumstances. For example: being out of Canada for a period of time or going to University. Their file will be marked "Inactive".

<u>Note 4</u>

All lapsed membership renewals will be considered on a case-by-case basis.

<u>Note 5</u>

Only those **Qualified Members** who have been "In Good Standing" for a minimum of three consecutive years will be considered for adjudicating the National Championships.

General Members

May rejoin, at any time with no penalty, other than a late fee if rejoining after the deadline for the current year.
